Road Safety

Miss Burns went to a Road Safety course earlier in the year and the focus was on towards zero. It provided a powerful video of what someone thought was an appropriate number of deaths on the road until they gather that number of his loved ones. This video really hit and the importance of keeping everyone safe around the road especially during pick up and drop off.

As part of the Road safety it is important that when we are picking up our students that we are reverse parking in the correct spots where everyone can see your child and the children around them. When our children are in the car that they are sitting in a correct seat and have one seatbelt per child.

Next term we will be having more road safety lessons which focus on how to travel safely in a car and moving around cars in the car park. We will also be looking at wheel safety as well.

Class Dojo

The whole school is trialling a new behaviour system which uses the website class Dojo where the students and staff have applied areas they can get points for within the school and areas that they need to work on. It is focussing on improving learning time and working towards different rewards not only as an individual but as a whole school as each students individual mark affects the whole classes points.

We will be trialling it for the remainder of the term and for four weeks next term to see how we are going as a whole school.
