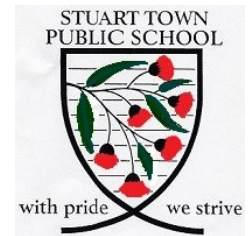


STUART TOWN PUBLIC SCHOOL
